

INSTRUCTIONS FOR OPEN SEASON BID CAPACITY

Available Capacity for Bid – May 15, 2007

Nebraska Resources Company, L.L.C. (“NRC”) is currently accepting bids for firm transportation service from a receipt point to be constructed within the Trailblazer Pipeline in Clay County, Nebraska in conjunction with the in-service date of early 2009 for the Nebraska Resources Pipeline (“NRC Pipeline”).

Please use the contacts provided below to inquire as to the availability of specific delivery points. Shippers will be responsible for tendering gas to NRC at the requested receipt point at the prevailing pressure of the NRC system, as it may exist from time to time. The applicable maximum recourse rates will be those stated in NRC’s Gas Tariff, as may be revised from time-to-time. NRC is not required to sell this capacity at rates less than the applicable maximum recourse rates.

Bidding Requirements:

All interested parties should fax written bid(s) by 4:00 p.m. central time on Friday, June 15th, 2007 to the attention of Jay House at (918) 477-3479. Shippers will be notified of bid results by 12:00 p.m. CCT on Friday, June 22nd, 2007.

All bids must contain the following:

Primary receipt point – Trailblazer Clay County, NE

Primary delivery point(s) – Call contacts listed below as to point availability.

Maximum Daily Delivery Quantity (MDDQ) by Delivery Point

Contract Term - Not less than 10 Years from the date of in-service of the full available capacity, as stated above.

If you are bidding less than the maximum recourse reservation rate, state the reservation rate bid. Such bids will only be considered in NRC’s sole discretion and shall constitute Negotiated Rate bids.

Transportation rates should be bid exclusive of applicable charges for commodity, ACA and Fuel, Lost & Unaccounted for (“FL&U”). These charges will be assessed per NRC’s Gas Tariff.

Other Information:

NRC reserves the right to accept or reject bids in whole or in part, or reopen bidding after initial bids have been received. NRC will review bids with the intent of optimizing value based on rate, term and volume and reserves the right to re-negotiate any component of the terms contained in the bid(s). NRC will consider bids in excess of ten years and will apply a discount factor of ten (10) percent in determining the NPV of a bid.
